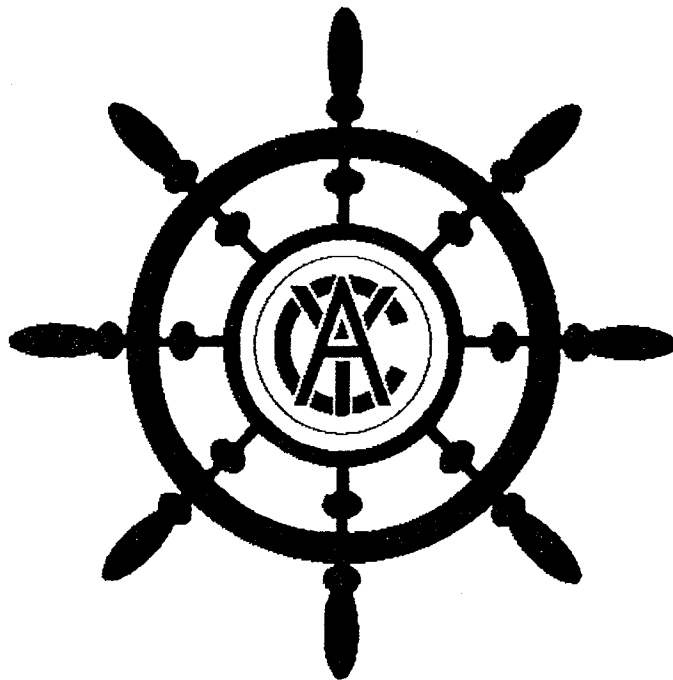

Articles of Incorporation

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the adult subscribers hereunto of the City of Appleton, County of Outagamie, and State of Wisconsin, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of Chapter 180 of the Revised Statutes of Wisconsin, of 1898, and all laws amendatory thereto.

Article I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be the Appleton Yacht Club and shall be located in the City of Appleton, County of Outagamie, and State of Wisconsin.

Article II

CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is organized for the pleasure and convenience of its members. It shall have no capital stock and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall ever be declared by this corporation to its members.

Article III

PURPOSE

The purpose for which said corporation is organized is to promote and foster the spirit of boating, to guard and protect the interests of members who are owners of powerboats, to inculcate among its members a knowledge of the rules of navigation and naval courtesy, to encourage and conduct races, cruises, club runs, water carnivals and aquatic events for the entertainments of the citizens of Appleton and to encourage harmony and good fellowship among its members in every way possible.

Article IV

PROPERTY

The corporation may purchase or lease such property, real and personal as may be necessary for its purposes, and may hold, improve, sell, lease, or sublet the whole or any part thereof in such manner as may be decided by the corporation, and not in conflict with the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

Article VI

DUTIES OF OFFICERS

SECTION 1. The Commodore shall preside at all of the meetings of the club and Board of Directors, and shall exercise all authority given him by the By-Laws governing the corporation. He shall have authority to call special meetings, appoint all committees not otherwise provided for, sign all orders upon the treasurer for such monies as by vote the corporation shall be ordered paid and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the By-Laws.

SECTION 2. The Vice Commodore shall in the absence or incapacity of the Commodore perform all the duties of the commodore.
